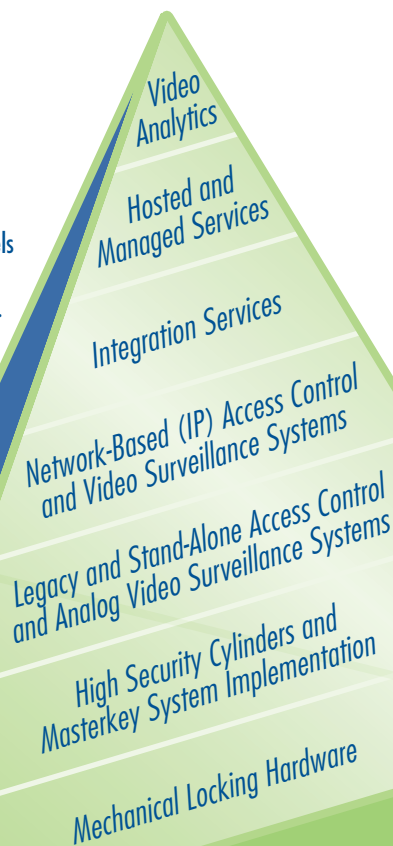
State-of-the-Art Security Integration
